Phonics Screening 2019 Next week, Phonics Screening takes place for the children in year 1—but what is it?

The Phonics Screening Check is meant to show how well your child can use the phonics skills they've learned up to the end of Year 1, and to identify students who need extra phonics help. The Department for Education defines the checks as "short, light-touch assessments" that take about four to nine minutes to complete.

The checks consist of 40 words and non-words that your child will be asked to read one-on-one with a teacher. Non-words (or nonsense words) are a collection of letters that will follow phonics rules your child has been taught, but don't mean anything – your child will need to read these with the correct sounds to show that they understand the phonics rules behind them.

The tests are nothing for parents to worry about but are used as a base for teachers to know which children need help to identify certain sounds. The best advice we can give parents is to read with your child at home! Reading stories together not only sparks their imagination but you could ask them to read with you which will help them use their decoding skills.
