Welcome to the start of the school year. I hope that you had a great summer and are ready for an exciting year ahead.

As ever at the beginning of a new year, there will be lots of messages and letters sent home together with forms for completing. We will try to keep these to a manageable level and will start sending some home next week so please check the bookbags regularly. As the year progresses we are going to try to send more communications via email so please make sure you keep your email addresses up to date with the office.

It is wonderful to see the pupils in their smart uniform and it is a real help to pupils, staff and parents, if you can please make sure items of clothing are labelled with your child's name. Similarly, please make sure drinks bottles are clearly named.

Maths. Pupil log in details and information will follow during the term, along with details of our reading band scheme.

I expect to send a calendar of dates for the academic year 2019 – 2020 next week. Additional dates will occur throughout the year and we will inform you of these via our newsletter and the calendar on the school website.

I would be grateful if you could make a note of the test weeks as it is really important that your child is in school during that time:

- \* Year 6 tests week beginning 11th May

The dates for the Year 1 phonics, Year 4 and Year 6 tests are statutory and can therefore not be done at any other time.
