





### Reminder—school meals for current Year 2's

Please remember that the universal infant school meals are available to those children up to the end of Year 2. Children in years 3 and above will have to pay for their lunch which is currently £2.40 daily.

This means if your child is currently in Year 2, then school dinners will be chargeable from September 2018.
