United Downs Deep Geothermal Power Project Drop-In on Tuesday 16th April 2pm – 4pm

There is another opportunity to visit the United Downs Deep Geothermal Power (UDDGP) project site during the Easter holidays on Tuesday 16th April any time between 2pm – 4pm. There will be members of the project team to talk to, information panels to browse, educational and project films to watch, get up close to some of the used drill bits and view the 52m high drilling rig from the viewing platform.

Drop-In sessions are free and suitable for all the family with colouring pages and an interesting facts trail. Under 18s must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. Visitor access is on foot through gate B and parking is available at gate C, which is a short walk from the drilling site. There is no public parking at the project site.
