Cinema Trip details:

On Tuesday 20 November 2018, the whole school will be travelling to Truro cinema to see a special schools screening of Paddington 2 (rated PG).

We will be leaving school at 9am by coach to travel to Truro ready for the film to start at 10am. The children will need to wear their school uniform so they can be easily identified amongst the other schools who will be there.

The film is due to end at mid-day and we will return to school for a late lunchtime. Unfortunately, our caterers are unable to keep the school dinners warm for this later time so the children will need to bring in a packed lunch from home or order a school packed lunch.

I am pleased to say that the cost of this trip is part subsidised by the Into Film Festival but I am asking for a voluntary contribution of £2.50 per child towards the cost of coach travel.
