19th November - Rag Bag collection

Bags will be sent out next week, for a collection on Tuesday 19th November (please do not bring bags to school until Monday 18th).

adult and children's clothing (no school uniform),

Please note, if not listed, then it cannot be accepted, nor will they accept dirty, damaged or wet clothing.

If you fill your bag and have more, fantastic, just grab a black bin bag, and keep filling. Once collected on 19th Nov, they will check, weigh, recycle, and the best bit.....pay us based on weight, so the more bags the better!

22nd November – Movie Night – 6pm in the school hall


Tempest Photos

There are a few accounts that need to be brought up to date. We would appreciate it if you could please make sure your ParentPay accounts are settled before half-term.


