Robin class

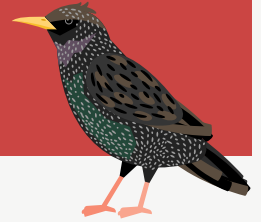

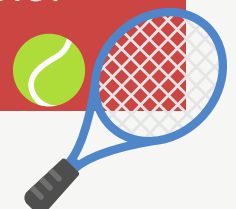


Starling class
