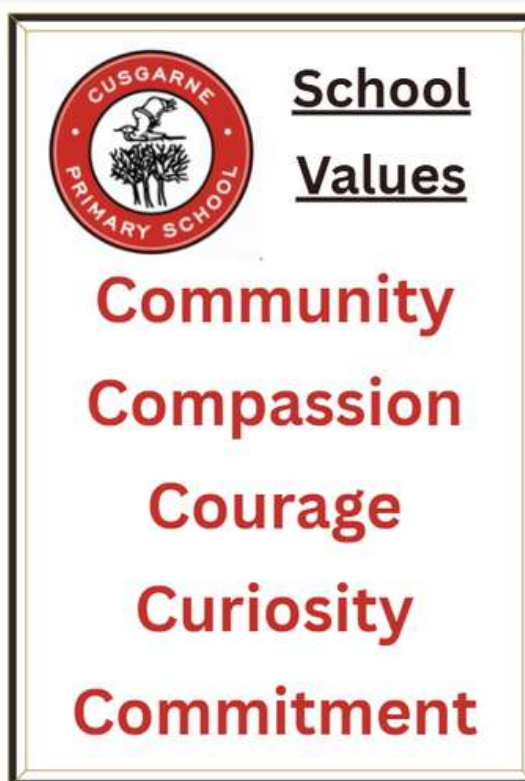

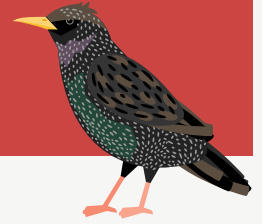

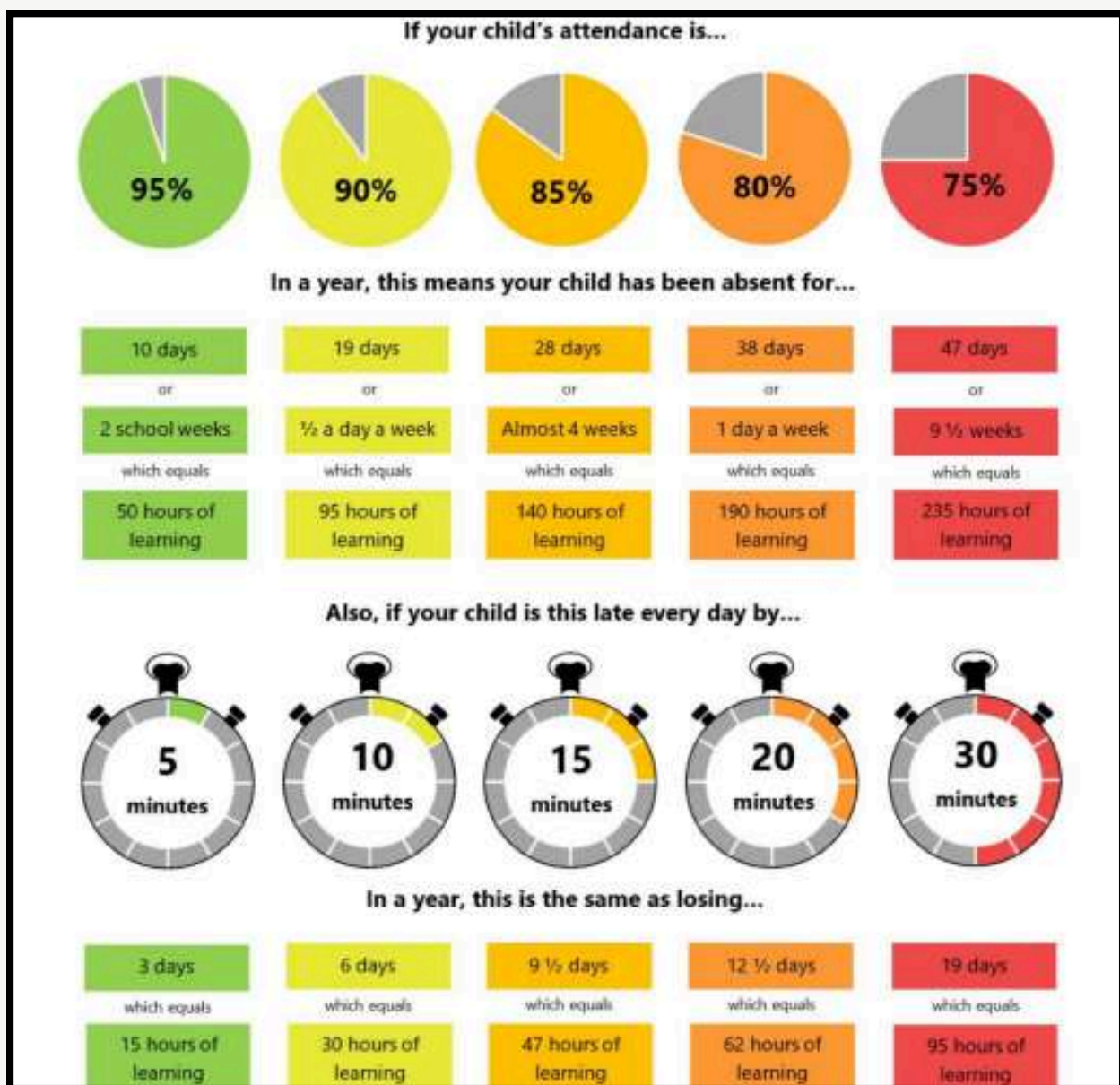


Next week, we are looking forward to returning to the farm to continue our learning and start our field journal.
