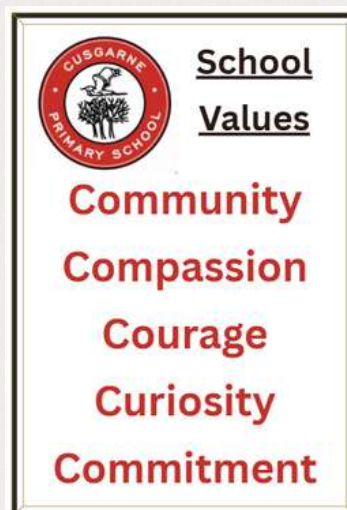

Next week, we will be making our stall for the Summer Fair. Robin Class (Mrs Turner) is feeling very competitive!

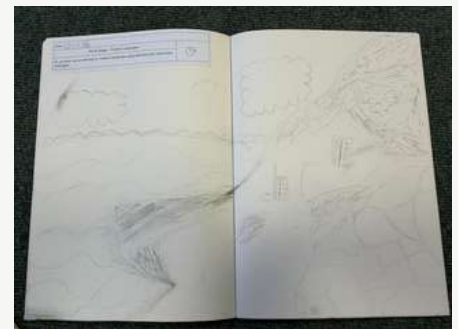
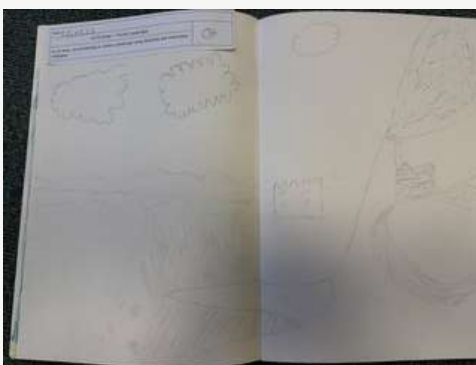
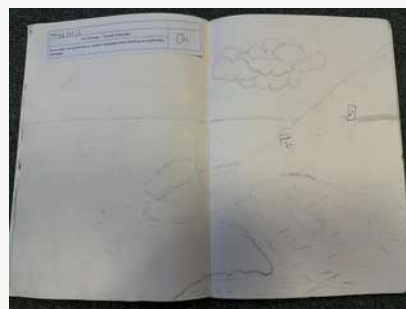


Class updates

Next week, we are looking forward to creating some of the resources for our stall at the Summer Fair!

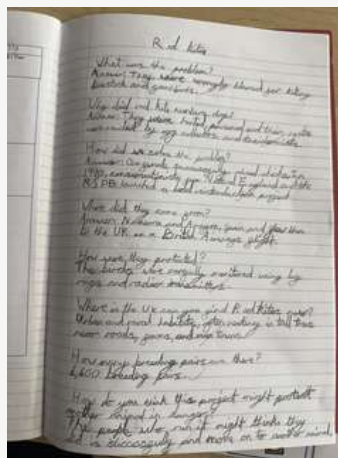
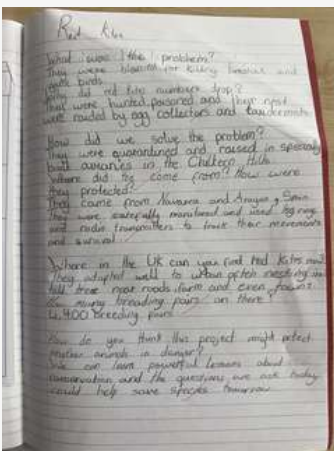


Class updates
