Summer Fair

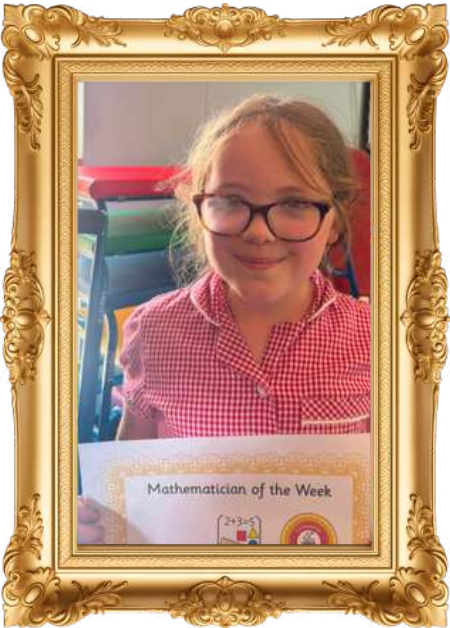
