

There have been some wonderful messages posted on the display board between the classrooms in celebration and in recognition of others personal qualities. Thank you to Jemma and Ethan for coordinating this across the school.

On Monday we were privileged to have Welsh & GB Olympic swimmer Calum Jarvis come in and visit the children during a special assembly. Calum won gold as part of the 4x200m relay team in this year's Tokyo Olympics, and has also competed in the World Championships, European Championships & the Commonwealth Games. Calum was born in Wales, but moved to Wadebridge at the age of 4, and now trains at Bath University. He brought an array of medals with him (including his Olympic gold!) and these were passed around for all the children to have a look at. Calum said he was here to inspire the children like he'd been inspired by his Paralympic swimming teacher when he was younger. We wish Calum all the luck as he is currently in training for the World & European Championships next year!
