Dear Parents

September has drawn to an end and we would normally be inviting you in for our Harvest assembly and auction. The children will be having a class assembly on Monday to celebrate Harvest and think about what it means to people and communities. Since we cannot gather in the usual donations for our auction, this year we are asking if families would consider popping an extra item or two in with their weekly shop and donate these to the local food bank. Most supermarkets have a food bank collection point and they are particularly in need of rice, fruit juice and toothpaste (but have plenty of tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce and long life milk).

Breakfast Club – From Monday 5 October, breakfast club will be re-starting but with some revised procedures. You will need to let us know **in advance** if your child needs booking into breakfast club and suggest that you email us weekly with the days required for the following week.

Breakfast club will run from 8am until 8.30am when the children will then meet up with the rest of the children in their classes. (Children in Starling class will stay with Mrs Pascoe until 8.45am).

We do need you to make sure you that you bring your children to the bottom gate at 8am where a staff member will be waiting to let them in. The gate will then be re-locked. This means that if you are running late, you may have to 'phone the school number and ask someone to come and let you in.

We will be running activities for the children but are having to separate the children according to their bubbles. For the time being, we will **not** be able to provide breakfast. If your child does need a breakfast, please provide this in a small tub. (We recommend items such as pre-wrapped croissants and bananas etc. but please have a chat with us beforehand.)

The cost is **£1.50** per child per day and can be paid via ParentPay.

Rucksacks – we have previously asked that children do not bring rucksacks into school - please will children just bring in bookbags and lunch boxes each day. We do not have room to safely store rucksacks and the year 6 lockers are used

for their PE kits on Wednesdays. Thank you for helping us keep the classes and school safe by abiding by this rule.

The nursing team are due into school on Monday 19 October 2020 so you need to complete the permission portal by Thursday 15 October at the latest. Please speak to Mrs Holmes or Mrs Hall if you would like more information.


Reminder – Thursday 22 October and Friday 23 October 2020 are both inset days and school will be closed to pupils.
