
Dear Parents

This week the children have started their end of year assessments. We will be reporting on their progress and next steps in their end of year reports.

Please make sure that you are following the latest guidance about reporting and going for testing should your child or any family member show signs of Covid. We do know of local schools who have had to shut bubbles and we really do not want this to happen at Cusgarne.

Public Health England do not recommend the use of lateral flow testing for children under the age of 11. Instead, if your child displays symptoms, they will have to isolate and have a PCR test. You MUST inform us that your child has symptoms and is going for a PCR test. If any parents do not take their child for a PCR test, they will have to self-isolate. Once the result is known, please let us know straightaway. If the test comes back as positive, the self-isolation period is 10 days and we will have to close the appropriate bubble.

We are once again in a fast moving situation so please be vigilant.





Following my letter home last week concerning the class structure next year, I am able to confirm that there will be NO change to the start and end times of the school day. The school day will start at 8.30am and finish at 2.45pm. We have had lots of positive feedback on these timings and it allows working parents the extra time to get to work.

Given the current guidance for schools, we will still be holding a Sports Day for the children but we are unable to invite parents. As a staff, we are really disappointed because we love the family event our Sports Day became.

Instead, we will have a KS1 Sports afternoon on Monday 12 July with KS2 having theirs on Wednesday 14 July. Should the weather be unkind, we will re-arrange for the following week.

We have also had to undertake a vigorous risk assessment which has been cleared to allow the Kingfisher Class to give their end of year performance, albeit to a reduced audience. We are delighted that the children will get the chance to shine because they have been working so hard learning lines and the songs. We know that the current restrictions imposed are not ideal for families but we welcome the opportunity for our year 5 and 6's to perform.
