I'd just like to reiterate the school uniform policy to you, the uniform requested is as follows:

- Red sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece. White shirt/blouse or polo shirt.
- Grey or black tailored trousers or skirts. Trousers are perfectly acceptable for airls.
- Red checked summer dresses for girls
- White socks or red/grey tights for girls.
- Sensible black shoes (no flashing lights, or branding). No trainers, skate shoes, high heels or open toe shoes.



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I also want to remind you that only healthy snacks & water (not squash or juice) are to be brought into school, no chocolate bars or crisps for snack time please. Key Stage 1 parents, your children have daily access to fresh fruit, and we find this really helps encourage healthy eating. The School Council completed a survey throughout the school and developed a poster around some of the healthy eating ideas that the children had, you can find a copy of this at the end of the newsletter. The findings of this survey will be delivered to the school either via assembly or in individual classes.

There will be an open afternoon for Robin class parents on the 28th March at 1.30pm-2.45pm. We'd love for you to come in, spend time with your child, and have a look at the new resources, as well as the new classroom organisation that we have in place. We would also like to introduce to you our new phonics scheme 'Little Wondle' with a short presentation, and we're hoping this will encourage you to get on board with it too.
