There will be a few changes to our school day when we return from the Easter holidays. The gates will open at 8.20am ready for the children to come into the playground, you can now use either gate for entering the school grounds, and the children will be expected to come in & line up outside ready for 8.25am. This earlier start ensures that they are then inside the classroom & ready to begin their day for 8.30am. The children will line up in the same way that they do at the end of playtime, however the teachers will be outside in the first week to familiarise both children & parents with the new routine.

There will be some new additions to class club after half term, and we also welcome the Reception children to attend if they wish. The schedule will be as follows:

Clubs will not run for the first week back after half term, so an online form will be sent out that week for you to request a place for your child. We are also hoping to offer wraparound care from 7th June, further information for this will be sent out next half term.

It was noted in last week's newsletter that the Year 6 SATS will be taking place on the 9^{th} & 10^{th} May. Please also note that there are an additional two days, so they will run from the 9^{th} – 12^{th} May. Apologies for any confusion caused.

There will be a meeting for Kingfisher Class parents to attend on Wednesday 27th April straight after school in the hall, and this will be an opportunity to discuss and confirm the details of the class trip to London in May. We also have some forms that need to be filled in by parents, so if you cannot make it then please let us know.

For the Year 6 parents who have children going to Richard Lander in September, we will be hosting a transition meeting in the school hall on Tuesday 7th June. The school will meet the children after lunch but have asked for parents to attend from 2.15pm onwards. This will allow you to ask any questions you may have.

We have some Parish news for you. Firstly, the Frogpool Chapel Courtyard shall open on Thursday 21st April. If you can make it then please do pop along, it contains the artwork that the children made with artist Vanessa Penrose, and I know the church would really appreciate your support. Secondly, the Parish are also holding jubilee celebrations in the Richard Jory playing field on Sunday 5th June. If you would like to attend then they require you to complete a form, this can be handed in at reception, and needs to be in by 30th April. I hope you all enjoy the Easter holidays, and we look forward to welcoming the children back on Monday 25th April. Remember we finish at 1pm tomorrow!




