Kingfisher class really enjoyed their Science experiment, investigating how the size of a shadow can change depending on how far it is from the light source. They measured the distance from the light source and the size of the shadow in centimetres, and then recorded their results in a table. They concluded that the nearer the object to the light source, the larger the shadow formed.

The awards seek to encourage learning, understanding and promotion of Cornish culture and give expression to the national Celtic spirit of Cornwall.
