Dear Parents,

It has been a challenging week with children displaying a range of symptoms, including those colds and autumn bugs that present themselves at this time of year, combined with the ongoing challenges of the pandemic which seems determined to affect all our lives in different ways. But through adversity and with determination, I wish to thank all my team and you as our community for helping to prevent these issues escalating beyond our immediate control. I thank you all for your understanding and support in arranging PCR tests and reporting results to us, so that we can be in no doubt that together we will keep this at bay and remain fully operational as a school community.

On Monday next week we have a visiting artist/potter that will be running workshops in every class throughout the day. The children will be creating work from clay to form an art installation in the courtyard of Frogpool Chapel. We are excited about this opportunity and community collaboration, as it forms an underpinned part of what we as a school believe in and broadens our children's experiences. We know that they will feel pride in their work being displayed in a public community space for all to admire. Please could I ask they bring in an old plain T-shirt to wear during the workshops to stop the messy clay getting on their uniform.

Although we have not been able to celebrate Harvest as a whole school again this year, the children would like to mark the occasion by thinking of others, and by donating to support the local food bank. This decision has been made by the school council, following feedback from their classes.

On Friday this week, or on Monday or Tuesday next week we would like children to bring in food items that we will donate to the local food bank. We have a new member of staff that started with us on Monday as our new school secretary, alongside Mrs Hall - I would like to welcome Mrs Sleeman to the Cusgarne team, I know that she will be a huge asset to our school, and the children have already been making her feel welcome!



Huge congratulations to the children who have been appointed School Council representatives from each class. I know they will do a terrific job and I believe they have already had their first meeting – see some information about their plans below.

The Friends of Cusgarne School are holding a fundraising event next week – details included below in the newsletter. Some new committee members have taken the helm and already have lots of exciting idea and plans, so keep an eye on their noticeboards on the school gates! As always, I and the rest of the staff are so grateful to the Friends for everything they do.

Target 1- Recycling: School Council wish to remind parents that all crisp packets can be placed in the bin outside by the bottom gate. These packets are then recycled and contribute to fund raising for school. Also, each class is going to



reintroduce paper recycling. This is part of our drive and awareness for our children of the importance of making small changes to make a big difference in this time of climate change.

Target 2- Harvest: Although the children know we can't hold a Harvest Festival this year, they are asking all parents to give their child some food to bring into school from Friday and/or Monday or Tuesday next week, so that School Council can give it to the foodbank.

Target 3- Children in Need Day (November 19th): School Council are planning to hold a non-uniform day and hold a cake sale, to raise money for this cause. The Council will meet again after half term to discuss Children in Need Day further, and more details will follow via the Newsletter.

Target 4- School Council would like to improve the sports equipment in the playground and are going to ask the year 6s to run some lunchtime sports clubs.
